About the Clinton Police Department:

The Clinton Police Department is located on the shoreline between New Haven and New London. The police department provides first responder services to approximately 13,000 full-time residents and a transient daily population of approximately 40,000 people.

The Clinton Police Department is authorized for 27 sworn personnel, consisting of a Chief, a Patrol Captain, a Support Services Captain, 5 Sergeants, 5 Corporals, 1 Detective, 1 K9 officer, 1 SRO, and 11 police officers assigned to the Patrol Division. Special Assignments within the Patrol Division include the Marine Unit, Youth Group, Car Seat Install Program, R.A.D., D.A.R.E., Bicycle Officer and more.

Contractual benefits include a 4 on 2 off, 8-hour day schedule for Patrol, defined pension benefits (currently 10 year vesting, negotiations pending), medical insurance (State Partnership Plan 2.0, 18% current employee cost share), Dental (Cigna, 18% current employee cost share), Vision (18% current employee cost share), paid vacation, paid holidays, paid personal leave, paid sick time, paid funeral leave, paid maternity/paternity leave, comp time accrual, advanced education stipend, longevity stipend, and annual uniform allowance.
