NOW ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS FOR ENTRY LEVEL POLICE OFFICER

The Township of Hanover Police Department will be hosting an entry level Probationary Police Officer written exam on October 2nd at 6:00pm along with a physical exam on October 12 at 7:00am

Applicants ***MUST*** meet ONE of the following qualifications:

A) Possess two ***or*** more years' experience as a full-time police officer. Certified officers applying from states other than NJ will be required to attend the Morris County Police Academy in full or on waivers depending on the circumstances.

B) Possess a Bachelors degree in any field of study

C) Is either currently enrolled ***or*** has successfully completed a Police Academy Alternate Route Program recognized by the New Jersey PTC

D) Must have 60 college credits ***and*** two (2) years active military service ***or*** a combination of military service and college credits. (Must provide DD 214 as proof of military service)

Degrees must be from an accredited college or university and be recognized by the American Council on Education as listed in the Accredited Institutions of Post-Secondary Education.

Applicants must also meet the following minimum requirements of the State of New Jersey:

- Must be a citizen of the United States of America.
- Must be a resident of the State of New Jersey.
- Must possess a valid New Jersey Driver's License at the time of appointment.
- Must not be less than 18 year of age or more than 35 years of age, at the time of appointment. In accordance with NJ statutes, age exemptions for military service and prior law enforcement service may be granted to meet the maximum age standards.
- Must pass a comprehensive background investigation
- Must demonstrate proficiency in writing and basic computer skills.
- Must be physically capable of meeting the required firearms qualifications mandated by the Attorney General Guidelines.
- Must be psychologically fit to perform all duties of a police officer.
- Must meet the requirements set forth in the job description for police officer.

- Must be able to read, write, and speak the English language well.
- Be of good moral character.
- Candidates must be available to work any schedule, shift, or assignment as ordered by the Chief of Police or his designee.
