The Wyckoff Police Department is accepting applications for the position of Class III Special Police Officer for the upcoming 2023 - 2024 School Year. The Class III Special Police Officer, under the direction of the Chief of Police, shall conduct school safety and security duties within the Township of Wyckoff. This is a Part-Time position that requires working on days when school is in session. No health, dental or prescription benefits are offered with this position. However, the employee will be eligible to receive paid time off.

### The rate of pay is \$40.00 per hour.

#### **Minimum Qualifications:**

The applicant must:

- Be a resident of the State of New Jersey during their term of appointment.
- Be able to read, write, and speak the English language with reasonable proficiency and possess a High School diploma or equivalent.
- Be sound in body and of good health and successfully pass a drug screen, medical testing certified by a physician licensed to practice in the State of New Jersey and psychological testing required for employment with the Wyckoff Police.
- Be of good moral character and must not have been convicted of any offense involving dishonesty as would make the applicant unfit to perform their duties.
- Be a retired law enforcement officer less than 65 years of age who served as a duly qualified, fullytrained, full-time police officer in any municipality or county of this state, or as a member of the State Police, and was separated from that prior service in good standing within three (3) years of appointment to this position.
- Be able to produce a letter of good standing issued by the agency from which they retired including the date and type of retirement.
- Be physically capable of performing the functions of the position in accordance with the Police Training Commission (PTC).
- Possess a NJ Police Training Commission Basic Police Officer Certification or NJ State Police Academy Certification.
- Possess a valid New Jersey Driver's License
- Successfully pass a background investigation.
- Complete School Resource Officer Training within one (1) year of employment. Preference may be given to officers already SRO trained and have served as an SRO.

Applications will be considered upon receipt, and applications will be accepted until the position is filled. Interested applicants must submit an application and resume outlining their qualifications for this position.
