WARREN TOWNSHIP POLICE CLASS III SPECIAL POLICE OFFICER

The Warren Township Police Department (Somerset County) is currently accepting applications for the position of Class III Special Police Officer.

The Class III Special Police Officer, under the direction of the Chief of Police, shall conduct school safety and security duties specifically at the Morris Union Jointure Commission Developmental Learning Center (MUJC-DLC) located in Warren Township. Interaction with the students regarding behavioral incidents will not be the responsibility of the Class III Special Police Officer.

SALARY/SCHEDULE

- Hourly Rate: \$40 (up to 35 hours per week)
- 11-month schedule to include hours during the summer

PREREQUISITES

- Be a retired law enforcement officer, within the last three years, and less than 65 years of age who served as a duly qualified, fully trained, full time police officer in any municipality, or county of the State of New Jersey.
- Be capable of passing all required training mandated by the New Jersey Attorney General Guidelines and Police Training Commission (PTC) as well as successfully complete the School Resource Officer Certification Course.
- Any applicant offered a conditional offer of employment will be required to pass a medical examination, psychological screening, and drug screening pursuant to the New Jersey Attorney General Drug Testing Policy.
- Be a resident of New Jersey with a valid New Jersey Driver's License.
- Applicant(s) must successfully pass a background investigation.
- Applicant(s) must possess a New Jersey PTC Basic Police Officer Certification.
- Applicant must be physically capable of performing the functions of the position.
- Applicants must provide a letter of good standing from the Chief of Police or Officer in Command of the agency they retired from, to include their dates of employment, and type of retirement.
